Carrara is a metamorphic white stone, quarried in the Carrara region in Italy. It has been used for thousands of years for construction. In Roman times, this stone, which was considered prestigious, was already used to build buildings, and for statues, pillars, and gates in external structures.

Over the years, with the development of the usage of marble, this stone has become the industry's most prestigious stone for flooring and countertops.

Currently, the stone is used in the field of marble and terrazzo and for floor coverings.
